**FINDINGS OF FACT**

Respondent knew, or should have known that she was required to renew her license on or before August 31, 2020.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The conduct and circumstances as stated in the above Findings of Fact constitute a violation of A.R.S. §32-2027(A) “A licensee or certificate holder shall renew the license or certificate pursuant to board rules. Except as provided in section 32-4301, a licensee or certificate holder who fails to renew the license or certificate on or before the expiration date shall not practice as a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant in this state.”

**ORDER**

**Probation:** The Arizona State Board of Physical Therapy hereby orders that Respondent, holder of License No. LPT-006299, be placed on probation for a period of ninety (90) days to commence upon the effective date of this Order with the possibility of early termination. Failure to comply with the

terms of probation shall be subject to the Noncompliance term of the Order. The Board orders Respondent to comply with the following terms and conditions of probation:

**Notification to Employer(s), Patients and Third-Party Payers:** Respondent shall submit evidence of having notified his employer(s), patient(s) and payor(s) of the administrative suspension of her license from September 1, 2020 through September 8, 2020. Notification must be made by certified mail with the green slips from the certified mail being scan and sent to the Board office as verification.

**Continuing Education:** Respondent shall take and complete continuing education in the areas listed below within six (6) months from the effective date of this order. Respondent must submit to Board staff for approval prior to beginning the continuing education courses, a syllabus of each course. Respondent shall provide documentation to Board staff that the course was completed prior to any termination of probation is considered.

- a. Respondent shall take and complete a minimum of six (6) hours of continuing education in the area of **Ethics**. Courses can be completed on-line.

**Civil Penalty:** Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$260.00 dollars.

**Jurisprudence Exam:** Respondent shall take and pass the Arizona Jurisprudence Examination (AZ Law).

If not accepted the Board will forward the case to an Informal Hearing Dr. Bustillo seconded the motion. Following review and discussion, the motion carried by roll call.

A) Review, Discussion and Possible Action for **Informal Hearing:**

1) Case No, 20-03; Mitchell Allen, PTA (9 am)

Mr. Allen was present and was not represented by counsel. The Board members and Board staff introduced themselves. Both Mr. Allen introduced himself. Dr. Cornwall read a summary of how the hearing would be conducted and reviewed the possible outcomes of the hearing. Ms. Richardson and Mr. Allen were sworn-in as witnesses. Ms. Richardson read the allegations against Mr. Allen.

Mr. Allen provided an opening statement.

The Board reviewed and discussed the case and asked questions of Mr. Allen.

No closing statement was provided by Mr. Allen

Dr. King moved the Board adopt the following Findings of Fact:

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

Per Mr. Allen's written response and interview, he admits that he did not verify the patient's identity before initiating treatment.

Mr. Allen had treated WA four days prior, on 12/26/19.

On 12/30/19 Mr. Allen performed Physical Therapy treatment on the incorrect patient. He was unable to identify which patient he treated.

Mr. Allen documented his 12/30/19 treatment in WA's chart when WA was in the hospital.

Per Mr. Allen's written response and interview, At Home Healthcare reversed the charge in the billing for the visit on 12/30/19 for WA.

The reversal of charges for WA can't be confirmed. Multiple requests under subpoena were made for billing documents, but At Home Healthcare failed to respond.

Based on Mr. Allen's written response and interview, Mr. Allen believed that he was treating the correct patient on 12/30/19.

Mr. Allen documents Ms. Ikoh as his supervising therapist when she was on vacation 12/24/19-1/2/20. There may have been confusion for Mr. Allen as to who would be his supervising therapist when Ms. Ikoh was out of town. Mr. Allen states that he believed that Mr. Tarr was his supervising



therapist for significant issues, but that he could contact Ms. Ikoh as well. In her email to Mr. Allen immediately prior to going on vacation, she states “let me know if you have any questions.”

In her interview, Mr. Ikoh states that she set the expectation that Mr. Allen could “reach out to her” about the patient caseload if he “really had an issue or question”.

**A.R.S. §32-2044(14):** “Making misleading, deceptive, untrue or fraudulent representations in violation of this chapter or in the practice of the profession.”

Dr. King moved the Board to issue a **Board Order** to include:

**ORDER**

**Probation:** The Arizona Board of Physical Therapy hereby orders that Respondent, holder of Certificate No. PTA-012790, is placed on probation for **twelve (12) months** from the effective date of the order **with the possibility of early termination.** The probation may be extended or other enforcement actions taken in the event Respondent is found in violation this Order or violates the Arizona Physical Therapy Practice Act. The Board orders Respondent to comply with the following terms and conditions:

**Continuing Education:** Respondent shall take and complete continuing education in the area(s) listed below within twelve (12) months from the effective date of this order. Respondent must submit the course description to Board staff for approval prior to beginning the continuing education course(s). On-line and in person courses will be considered for pre-approval by Board Staff. Respondent shall provide documentation to Board staff that the course was completed prior to the Board’s consideration of termination of probation.

- a. Respondent shall take and complete a minimum of six (6) hours of continuing education in the area of **documentation.**
- b. Respondent shall take and complete a minimum of three (3) hours of continuing education in the area of **ethics.**

**Jurisprudence Exam:** Respondent shall take and pass the Arizona Jurisprudence Examination (AZ Law).

**Documentation Review:** Between 30 days and 120 days of the completion of Respondent’s continuing education, the Board's Investigator will perform a minimum of one review of three (3) randomly selected charts for patients treated by Respondent. Respondent must contact the Board’s Investigator and provide the Investigator with a list of patients Respondent has treated during a period of time designated by the Board Investigator. The purpose of the review is to assess compliance with the Board's statutes and rules. If review of the charts described above reveal that the Respondent's records are not in compliance with the Board's statutes and rules, Respondent shall submit to additional reviews of patient charts where the Board's Investigator will perform another review of three (3) randomly selected charts for patients treated by Respondent. The purpose of the reviews is to assess compliance with the Board's statutes and rules. Respondent may petition the Board for relief of the reviews if respondent disagrees with the Board Investigator’s findings.
