

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL APPLICANTS FOR LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION**

**~ EXAM DATES, DEADLINES AND BOARD MEETINGS ~**

An application will be reviewed at a public meeting of the Arizona State Board of Physical Therapy (“BOARD”) for determination of licensure after all required documentation has been received in the Board office by deadline. **Please note: Board Meeting Deadline means all required documentation must be received in the Board office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the date listed as the deadline. Deadlines are firm.**

**ADA accommodations:** Applicants requesting ADA accommodations must have approval of the requested accommodations given at a Board meeting. Licensure/certification is given when passing scores are received at the Board office.

**Good Moral Character (GMC) YES answers:** Applicants who have given a YES answer to any of the Good Moral Character questions listed on the application must receive permission to test during a Board meeting. Licensure/certification is given when passing scores are received at the Board office.

**Foreign Trained Applicant:** A foreign trained applicant must receive permission to test at the time their application is reviewed at a Board meeting.

Applicants with Yes answer(s) must have the approval of the Board to sit for the exam(s). The determination will be made once all other required documentation has been received. The determination of approval will be made at a regularly scheduled public Board meeting. The Board will also determine if licensure may be issued once the passing score(s) have been received in the Board office.

**\* Applicant who is a graduate of a CAPTE-Accredited School of Physical Therapy**

AZ PT Board staff will approve a request to schedule the NPTE and/or the AZLAW exam once all required documentation has been received. *Please register to take the exam(s) at [www.fsbpt.org](http://www.fsbpt.org) as soon as you are ready to take the exam(s). Once staff electronically approves your request to take the AZLAW / NPTE, an email will be sent to you. You may check your exam approval status as well as pass/fail result at [www.fsbpt.org](http://www.fsbpt.org) by accessing "Status of My Request."*

**\* Applicants for licensure who have graduated from a Non-CAPTE accredited school** must have the approval of the Board in order to sit for the exam(s). Approval is determined by the Board at a regularly scheduled public Board meeting once all required documents have been received. Applicant will be notified of the Board's decision by email and regular mail.
